The theatre is a very large blue building.**

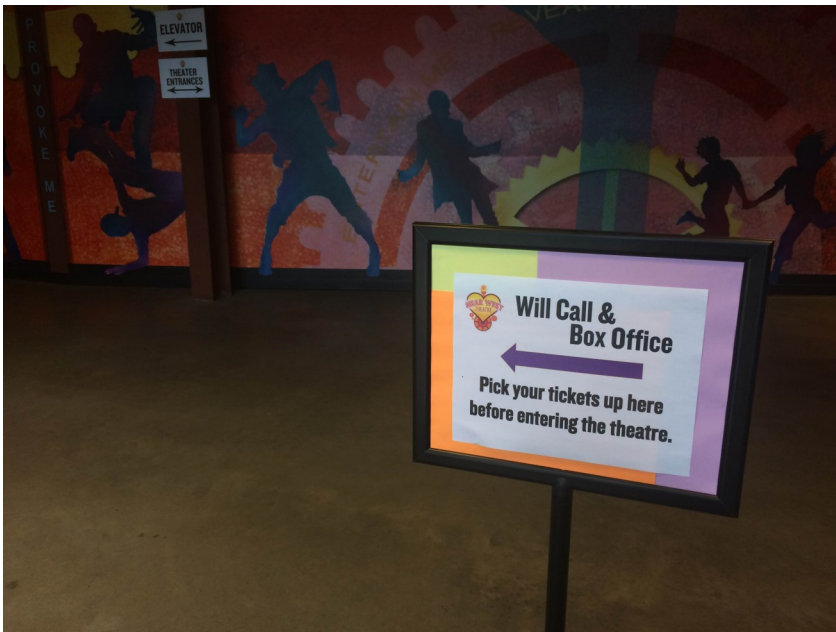




**Once we enter the front doors
