





DIRECTOR'S NOTE

As a young kid, I never listened to Elvis Presley music. My mom was so great about exposing us to all genres: Stevie Wonder, Celia Cruz, The Four Seasons, Donna Summer, The Beatles, I mean the list goes on and on. Elvis never made the cut. I knew the songs but they did not get played often in our home. I remember watching Forrest Gump and finding it humorous that Elvis was a visitor in Forrest's home and stole his dance moves. When this project was first presented to me by a colleague I thought, hmm? I read the script – found it to be somewhat problematic – and wondered, How can I have real and honest conversations with our young artists about the material in this show? I started to watch some documentaries, not only about Elvis, but about the actual time period that encompasses this show. Some of the social and political realities are very much the same in 2023. Despite so much good work, we are still living in a world where people want to have a say in who we love, what to do with our bodies, how we should identify. And although we can share the same water fountains, folks are still treated differently based on the color of their skin.

Now I know you are thinking, "Gee Trinidad, it's just a musical!" However, this is where the real conversation began with this amazing cast.

Hearing their stories, learning about the challenges they've faced, and how they related to the issues in this show was an eye-opening experience. It made me see this show in a different light. All Shook Up isn't about a man who comes to town and changes everyone and everything. It's about the change that occurs when the characters allow their hearts and minds to open, even when they don't understand. It's about acceptance -- of others and one's self. It's also about having the courage to be yourself and to speak up! I have a lot of faith in the generations to come. I hope they continue to be loud and proud and challenge those who want to take that right away from them. I know this is "just a musical," but sometimes what you learn onstage can be more life-changing than what you experience off of it. I hope these young artists will continue to shake up this world and this country!
