



DIRECTOR'S LETTER

It never ceases to amaze me what can be achieved when a group of people decide to set their minds to something.

More so, it never ceases to inspire and move me when a group of teens realize the power they have within themselves to change their circumstances.

This summer has been a whirlwind putting up such a massive undertaking as *Legally Blonde*. This show has big production numbers, challenging vocals, and characters whose stories are not always easy to tell. There is tons of comedy and even more heart to dig into and discover. It is a show that benefits from an abundance of time: to learn, to explore, to finesse; the kind of time that unfortunately has not been a luxury of ours these last 8 weeks.

Despite that, the 41 teens you see onstage never stopped working to truly bring this story to life. They chose to not let anything stand in their way, to not let anyone tell them they're not capable of greatness, and they continue to make that choice every time they tell this story.

Legally Blonde is the journey of a girl not truly seen by the world around her. She is immediately dismissed by some, seen as a joke to others, and underestimated at every turn.

Yet she does not let that stop her from pursuing her greatness. She does not let that diminish the light she brings to the world.

I would like to think that there's a little bit of Elle Woods in all of us. She is not dumb or even necessarily naïve. Elle simply chooses to see the good in the world around her, and when it's not there, she chooses to be the good and to bring it out of everyone she encounters.

At some point in our lives we've all seen that goodness surrounding us, whether in the innocence of childhood or following many years of growth in a world that so often tries to prove otherwise. We've all felt unseen, all at one point or another had our potential dismissed, all been underestimated – sometimes even by ourselves.

But what Elle Woods teaches us is that as long as we stay true to ourselves and hold fast to our beliefs, we can never fail to live the life we are capable of. She shows us that we can be a force for better, even when surrounded by those telling us it's not possible.

This cast has shown me that time and time again this summer. I am certain they will continue to do so beyond the stage for many years to come, knowing the power they hold within themselves to shape the world around them into one truly for the better.

It has been my privilege to spend my summer guiding these artists and witnessing the light they emanate. I hope when you leave the theatre today that its shine will have reminded you of all that you are capable of as well. TPOG



Benjamin is the recipient of the Kleban Foundation Award and a Jonathan Larson Grant.





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
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
