DIRECTOR'S LETTER

Welcome Friends,

After seven years as executive director of Near West Theatre, it has been a wonderful journey directing a NWT main stage production. I want to thank the entire production team, crew, community, NWT staff and Trinidad Snider for their support and grace throughout this process. I especially want to share my gratitude for the Scrooge! cast for their constant dedication and passion around this story and our unique approach in telling it. Our performers are a beautifully diverse mix of longtime NWT alumni and fresh new voices, bringing together a rich tapestry that embodies our values and celebrates our community.

In some form or another, we are all familiar with the Charles Dickens classic and many of us include this story as tradition every holiday season. Over these last few months, I have been asking myself why? Why does this story still resonate so strongly after almost 200 years?

I believe the themes of this tale are still relevant today. We are introduced to a broken man who firmly believes the accumulation of wealth, even at the suffering of others, is righteous. Rather than lifting up the poor, he supports institutions that "decrease the surplus population". Wealth is power and poverty is a disease of the weak. We read or watch this story and understand in our hearts he is wrong and sad in his thinking, yet many of us make celebrities and leaders out of these same men today. We experience versions of Scrooge in our daily lives, and even more importantly, within ourselves.

We want to believe in the goodness in man and root for his redemption. Evil is created, not born. We witness and embrace Scrooge's early childhood trauma, the loss of his sister, and his love lost as a young adult. By feeling his pain, we understand how values can become misguided after such suffering. For me, his journey to redemption truly begins when he allows himself to feel the suffering of others through Tiny Tim. Empathy and humility are truly righteous values.

We all have the power to be good. It is a choice.

Near West Theatre produced Scrooge! almost ten years ago and featured a friend who believed in the power of good. He suffered his fair share of trauma yet made the choice every single day to be a light to those around him.

My work in this production is dedicated to him.

Let us all be a light to others this holiday season.
