

A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

I remember when I was younger and I wanted to talk about real life issues with adults that there were many times when I was not welcomed. There was always this feeling of not being able to participate in dialogue or conversation because of my age. I was too young. I didn't have enough life experience to have an opinion. What did I know about trauma at a young age? This is how I was made to feel on many occasions. It's one of the reasons I fell in love with a Near West Theatre when I walked through the doors over 30 years ago; here was a place where adults wanted to hear from teens. Teens like me. My opinions, my thoughts and my ideas were valued not only as a person but as an artist.

As we approached the beginning of this pandemic and quarantine, the first thing we wanted to do was reach out to our community and see how everyone was. We gathered together on our Circle Up calls over Zoom and checked in with everyone. Kids, teens, and adults alike. A safe space to share exactly where you were. The most interesting thing out of that experience was the fact that these young voices were uplifting and inspirational. Every concern they had was countered with a "we can get through this" and "things will be OK" approach. Their voices helped me. It inspired me to start having those bigger, more difficult conversations at my own dinner table, with my own kids so that there was a space where they could share their voices, their concerns, and their journey through all of this.

This generation has something to say. I knew that whatever we were going to do first as a production had to be from their perspective. From their experiences, from them. For 12 weeks, two nights a week, for one hour, we sat on Zoom calls and talked about what was happening in the world. Their fears, their journeys, and their lives. And here we are today ready to share that with you all. I feel incredibly blessed to have had the opportunity to hear from them all and to see them grow as writers, poets, artists, and people.

The icing on the cake was being able to work alongside other teaching artists who I value and respect so much for their work, and their voices. Olivia Zink was new to us this year but truly understands and values everything that we do and believes in our mission. Mariah, Darius, and Scott all grew up at NWT, so they understand what it's like to be a young artist here. They were able to open up that same experience to these 30+ amazing kids. Jodi Kirk was one of our first teachers/directors at NWT who truly allowed us to have a voice at the table. She encouraged us to be seen AND heard. So to

have all of them with me on this journey was another opportunity to come full circle as I continue on my NWT journey. We have so much to learn as artists in this new creative environment and I am excited to see what we come up with. And I will say this: nothing is going to be perfect. We can all look at the things we create and find imperfections and things we wish we would've done differently. I choose to take a chapter out of the book that has been created by these young artists: I choose to look ahead with hope. I choose to try to be a better person in this world. I choose to fight for what is right. I choose to grow. I choose LOVE.

A NOTE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Welcome to our production of Rise: The Isolation Project!

Evaluating opportunities for accessibility and inclusion has been a priority historically for Near West Theatre and continues today. Two years ago, we embarked on a strategic planning process that would become our roadmap for change, investments, and mission-centric growth for several years. We knew then that accessibility and inclusion were key values of our mission, and goals were created to ensure our commitment into our future. This included identifying and addressing barriers that may exist that limit participation or opportunities for engagement in everything we do.

This included our ticket prices.

We already had some of the lowest prices in town, but something never felt quite right. As I would engage our guests nightly, I couldn't help but observe an unintentional economic barrier being created between our more expensive center section seats and our cheaper seats to the sides. Is this what we intended for our community? Are we truly being inclusive and accessible while limiting where our audience can sit? Wouldn't we be more successful in creating a diverse community by finding a way to remove this economic segregation in our ticketing policies? Sometimes we face great challenges in balancing our need for revenue to sustain our mission versus our commitment to mission itself.

So, last season we tested a "Pay What You Can" model of ticketing for one Thursday performance per production. We were humbled to see the response and all the new faces who joined our Near West Theatre community. We assessed this pilot to be a success, but there were also more questions and challenges brought forward. How do we truly embrace our commitment while limiting this policy to only one show per production? Are we truly equitable in piloting this initiative only during our traditionally lowest revenue night of the week? How can families take advantage of this policy on a weeknight?

We needed to take the leap and embrace the risk.

We are now committed to removing all barriers to audience engagement by extending this opportunity to every performance in our main season lineup, for every seat in the house, and every virtual performance. Our new model focuses on equity and meeting people where they are. We have set our standard ticket at a suggested price of \$15 for any seat in the house. This is simply a reflection of a budgeting process defining what we would need to generate at 80% capacity compared to our investments on productions to break even. You are invited, and encouraged, to pay what you can afford – for some people that may be \$5, for others it may be \$25. Data shows that patrons will show up at a realistic level for their personal circumstance. We trust that this will hold true in our community as well, and we are excited to see what this does for our engagement in spite of the stressors of the pandemic.

When the time comes for in-person shows, the organization is eager to see how the new Pay What You Can access for every show will make all seats affordable for patrons. We are confident that by making the center seats available at any price, we will truly make our performances and entire theatre accessible to people and families of all financial means. Our community now has the opportunity of choosing any seats they like in an equitable and fair first-come, first-served basis.

When I first started at this organization three years ago, I went to an event and spent time getting to know George Hrbek – a founder and visionary along with Stephanie – who told me "Mike, I would have kept our ticket prices at \$1 if I could." That small statement told me a lot about our founders' commitment to the mission of Near West Theatre and the community we serve.

I can't wait for the day we open our house to audiences again, and when we do, I will be standing by the box office and happily accept that \$1 from anyone who wishes to experience our love for community and the transformational power of live theatre.

We are thankful to have you join us and to continue serving our mission during the immense challenges we face. Our prayers are with you all. Please stay safe. Love your neighbors. Make good choices. Vote.
